The '15' blue-green definitive (Farmer & Agricultural Symbols) was first issued 10 MAR 1980 on 'Large Star and India' watermark paper, perf. $14\frac{1}{2} \times 14$. In 1981 the same stamp was printed on 'Multiple Asokhan Capital' watermark paper, perf. $14\frac{1}{2} \times 14$ and in 1982 on the same paper, but perf. 13 x 13. The 1986 sheet had the imprint 'New Gumming - Wet Well and Press, I.S.P. Nashik Road'.

The 10.3.80 issue used Plates Cl to Cl3;

" 5.7.82 " " C27 to C42; Plates C44 to C88 have
