## WHAT'S NEW IN INDIA

Dr Gandhi's article on the reorganisation and demise of the railway mail service reminds us how little is known about this service, especially since independence. This, now, it is the time to put what we have on record.

Chris Bartlett has been tracing the early history of mail by rail in India, and Chris Haines has located in the early codes describing these sections of each code from records held in London in the India Office Library, London. Little seems to be recorded since independence except lists of RMS offices, which were static, at the railway station. I do know that Chris Haines on chris\_haines@ blueyonder.co.uk would welcome any records that members might have of postindependence covers bearing code marks where these can be identified with it a particular section of the cover's journey. Just the start you off, here are some of the division codes that were recorded by the 1966 postal manual and will be found on date stamps of the period.
